


Task 00:

<p>Present the task to the student. Point to the picture and to the chart on the student-response page as they are referenced. Read the task exactly as it appears below.</p> <p>Here is a picture that shows the weather conditions outside on one day. Place the cards onto the chart to record the weather conditions for the day shown in the picture. The cards describe different weather conditions.</p> <p>Present and read each option card aloud: Snow, Cold, Calm, Warm</p>	
<p>Prompt 1: Point to the first column of the chart and to the option cards on the student-response page as they are referenced. Read the prompt exactly as it appears below.</p> <p>Which card describes the wind for the day shown in the picture? Snow, Cold, Calm, Warm</p> <p>The student receives a score of 2 for a correct response. If the student does not respond, repeat the prompt <i>only once</i>, exactly as it appears above.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">If the student responds correctly, the student receives a score of 2.If the student responds incorrectly, the student receives a score of 1.If the student does not respond, the student receives a score of NR. <p>If the student does not respond correctly, pick up and place the correct option card in the response box and say: Calm describes the wind for the day shown in the picture.</p> <p>Leave the option card in place on the student-response page.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">2</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1</p> <p style="text-align: center;">NR</p>

<p>Prompt 2: Point to the middle column of the chart and to the option cards on the student-response page as they are referenced.
