





Connecting LaunchPad to Your Infinite Campus SIS

Follow the instructions below to set up an API connection between your Infinite Campus instance and LaunchPad, the data management tool for Pearson K12 assessments.

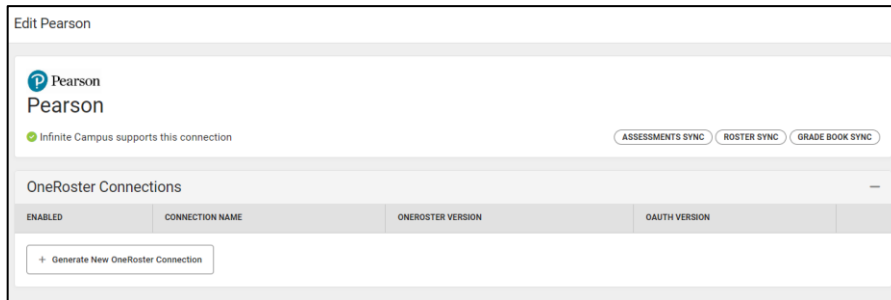
Step 1: Add or select the Pearson Application

1. Navigate to System Administration > Learning Interoperability
2. What you see on the 'Learning Interoperability' page will depend on your district's app licensing.

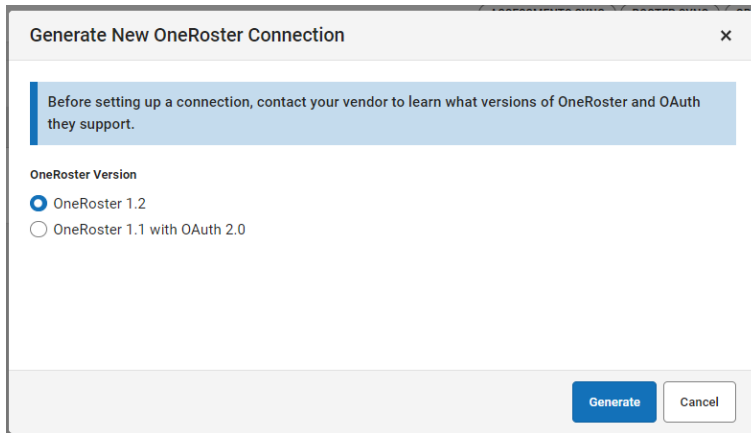
<p>If you see no applications listed here, click "Add Application." Name your new application "Pearson" and click Next to proceed.</p>		
<p>If you see a list of applications, search for Pearson. If Pearson is an option on your list of applications, select it.</p>		
<p>If Pearson does not appear as an option, click the "Connect to other Applications" option at the bottom of the application list page. Name your new application "Pearson" and click Next to continue.</p>		

Step 2: Add OneRoster Connection to the Pearson Application

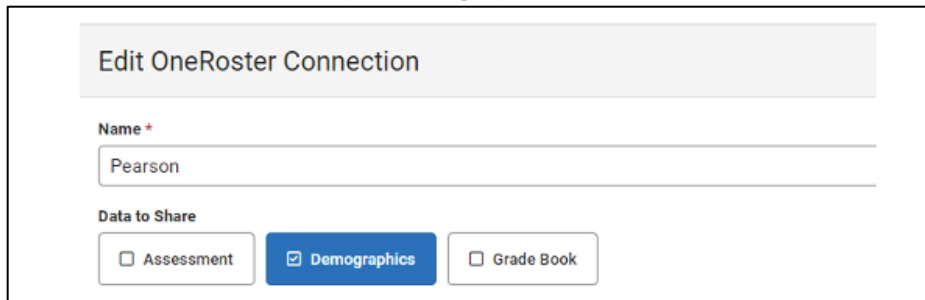
- From the Pearson Application, use the plus sign to expand the section, “OneRoster Connections section.”
- Click the button, “Generate New OneRoster Connection.”



- Select the OneRoster 1.2 version and click on Generate.



- From the “Edit OneRoster Connection” page, find the ‘Data to Share’ area. If more than one option is selected, uncheck all **except Demographics**.



Step 3: Share Connection Details

- From the “Edit OneRoster Connection page,” find the section called “Information to share with Pearson.”
- Open the following URL in a separate browser window. *This is a secure Pearson-managed online input form with limited access.*
